#### IV. Activities and experience in the field of human rights

As the **president** of the Czech Association for European and Comparative Law, I have led a professional organisation composed of more than 140 members from all legal professions. In this role, I have regularly participated in the meetings of the Steering Committee of FIDE (*Fédération Internationale pour le Droit Européen*) where each country is represented by one or two delegates (<u>https://www.fide-europe.org/national-associations/</u>). On the national level, I oversaw the organisation of various events, including an annual conference organised in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, as well as numerous workshops, lectures, and moot court competitions for law students.

As a **judicial law clerk** to Justice Kateřina Šimáčková and later to Justice Jan Wintr at the Czech Constitutional Court, I drafted concepts of judicial decisions of the constitutional court, the primary institution devoted to the protection of human rights and the rule of law in the Czech Republic. Most of the cases concern individual constitutional complaints by persons who claim human rights violations in all areas of law (civil, criminal, administrative); the constitutional court works not only with the national Charter of Fundamental Rights and Freedoms, but also with the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights which forms part of its constitutional framework of reference.

As a **practicing lawyer** (member of the Czech Bar Association since 2022), I have specialized in cases with human rights aspects, as well as cases with an EU law dimension, subcontracting my work to other advocates. I usually take up cases which are already being litigated and I advise advocates in litigation before the Supreme Court, the Constitutional Court, and the European Court of Human Rights.

As a **lecturer** and later **assistant professor** at Masaryk University, Faculty of Law, I have taught primarily courses in constitutional law (incl. human rights) and European constitutionalism (incl. both the European Union and the Council of Europe systems of human rights protection). I also specialise in skills development, i.e. courses such as law clinics, moot courts, and other skills-based courses, all in the area of human rights (incl. medical law clinic, media law clinic, and a number of human rights moot courts both at national and international level).

As a researcher, I lead an academic team of 10 junior researchers (DialogUE); we explore the preliminary ruling mechanism, i.e. the dialogue between national courts and the Court of Justice of the European Union. Within this capacity, I also give lectures to national judges under the auspices of the Czech Judicial Academy and the Slovak Judicial Academy.
